
Major Snowden has again been in charge of the Maintenance Work and Improvements at the Academy this summer, and you will be greatly pleased with the results when you arrive in September. The Parade Ground and athletic fields are in excellent condition (thanks to the ample rains we have had all summer), and the grounds and buildings are in better shape than ever before. Highlights of what to expect include the following:

- (1) McKinnon Hall completely repainted inside - all upstairs rooms
- (2) New ceramic tile shower bath installed in North Hall
- (3) New asphalt tile floor installed in hall and bathroom of North Hall
- (4) Interior (natural color knotty pine walls) of Phelps Hall revarnished
- (5) Johnston Hall repainted - entire outside and roof
- (6) 250 new dining room chairs placed in the Mess Hall
- (7) Two chairs in each cadet room instead of one only as heretofore
- (8) Red Ceramic tile placed on steps and porch to Mess Hall
- (9) Military entrance to Headquarters remodeled
- (10) New asphalt top on the basketball court and driveway next to Auditorium

Our 13th Annual Football Camp will be held on our own campus again this year, all "campers" reporting in Tuesday, 29 August, to be issued their equipment and get settled down, with the first "workout" late that afternoon. It will be a one-week football "school" for both Varsity and B-team players in the 9th grade and above. A letter will be sent out in a few days to football players and prospects, containing complete information, and enclosing reservation forms.

The enclosed physical examination form is to be completed by your family doctor and returned to the Academy as soon as possible. Both old and new cadets are required to furnish physicals prior to the opening of school, and any dental work needed should be attended to at once. A return envelope is enclosed for the convenience of your doctor in returning direct to us the physical examination report.
